District 3 Commissioner Bob Minning

Hello everyone and trust that you all had a great Labor Day weekend. There's a lot going on in our City and in District 3 so let's get started.



- First, let's give a BIG shout-out to our new City Manager for his first month on the job. And that he and his family will be residents of Sunset Beach.
- The City Commission did not move the Elevate T. I. program forward to a regular meeting, which means that none of the nine (9) proposed ordinances contained therein will not be heard. The reality is that the program could be brought back to the Commission at a future date with modifications.
- One of the primary issues that was to be addressed in the Elevate T.I. program was to set the guidelines for the use of fill material, both structural and non-structural. Of interest to our property owners was /is the use of NON-STRUCTURAL fill primarily associated with backfilling behind a raised sea wall project. Staff will now work on a standalone ordinance to cover such situations. Stay tuned.
- The dead palms on Paradise Blvd have been removed and will be replaced with ?????. Our PICA Beautification Committee will make the selection together with staff. Staff are redesigning the specifications for the median landscaping project now that most of the palms will remain. It will then go out for a bid. No timetable has been set at this time.
- SWFWMD has extended the restrictions on irrigation (lawn watering) to the end of December. The good news is that mother nature has stepped in, and we are receiving plenty of natural irrigation.
- City staff DPW have cleaned the storm drains on Treasure and Paradise Lanes.

Letter From Our Police Chief



I hope everyone had a great summer and I welcome you back if you have been away.

I would like to take a moment to talk to you about an issue that that we deal with every once in a while.....Scams. Scams are nothing new. They have been occurring for an exceptionally long time and some scammers have become very sophisticated in their methods, and they can appear in many places.

The best thing you can do is be very protective of your personal information. Scammers have a way of making their victims feel that they must act immediately and throw out terms to make the victim confused and distracted.

Anyone can be a victim of a scam but many times they will target someone who is elderly, using fast talking and technical terms.

Never give your personal information out over the phone unless you are sure that the person is legitimate, and that you called them.

Banks will not call you and ask for your personal info over the phone either.

Scammers will often ask for money to be sent via gift cards that you can purchase, that is another red flag. The bottom line here is that if it sounds too good to be true it probably is, and if you are confused or want verification, slow everything down and call someone you trust for help.

Landscaping changes along Paradise and Treasure Lane are currently on hold. Tree planting on Western Causeway Medium strip is on hold as well. There were 3 dead trees removed from the Gazebo Park on Treasure Land.

Hopefully in the Fall we will get some direction and movement on some of our landscaping projects.


